We have 12 junior counselor positions (6 male, 6 female) available for Christ's Explorers Camp this year. We will select the applicants that are best qualified for the leadership, responsibility, and youth interaction that is involved with the camp.

We hope that this will be a fun experience and a learning experience for our junior counselors! Junior counselors will have the opportunity to stay overnight in the cabins with the campers. Some junior counselors will be able to help plan and coordinate activities for the camp. All junior counselors will be able to participate in the camp activities, meals, and devotions!

Here are some examples of the duties for our junior counselors at Christ's Explorers Camp.

- Assist with set-up and clean-up of camp, including packing up supplies, food, and gear
- Help plan and coordinate various activities for the campers
- Be a role model to the campers by your mature conduct and respect for other people, the property and facilities, and your willingness to help
- Help check-in campers and load their gear into vehicles
- Supervision of campers during all planned activities, car rides, devotions, meals, and free time
- Help get campers to each planned activity/meal on time with the necessary materials and supplies
- Assist younger campers getting ready for activities – apply sunscreen and/or bug spray
- Assist camp counselors overnight in cabins – ensure safety and security of campers, help facilitate a fun atmosphere for the campers in the cabins, and help maintain order at all times
- Help take pictures and videos to upload on Facebook posts throughout camp
- Help serve and clean up meals
